


- 1 Good pair of Chinese blue and white porcelain dishes, each painted with two figures in a rocky landscape, the borders with floral panels on a diaper ground, Jiajing marks to base but 18th century, 21cm diameter £800-1,200
- Antique Chinese Kangxi period blue and white porcelain vase and cover, of cylindrical form with stepped base, painted with figures on horseback, total height 14cm £200-300
- 3 Large Chinese Qianlong period famille rose porcelain teapot and cover with moulded branch handle and spout, decorated in the Mandarin style with figural scenes, 27cm from spout to handle £250-350
- Fine antique Chinese famille verte porcelain baluster vase, probably Kangxi period, painted with a bird perched on a branch above flowers and a rocky outcrop, incised concentric circles to base and around neck, 20cm height £500-700
- Two Chinese 18th/19th century famille rose porcelain tankards, painted in the Mandarin style with figural scenes, the largest measuring 16cm height £200-300
- 18th Century Chinese porcelain tankard, of unusual proportions, decorated in the Imari palette with landscape scenes, 12cm height £80 -120
- 7 Two 18th century Chinese famille rose porcelain bowls, decorated with figures and flowers recpectively, and a similar milk jug, finely decorated with a figural scene £150-250



- Mid 19th century Derby (King Street Works) cottage shaped pastille burner and cover, enamel painted, inscribed Stevenson & Hancock mark to base, 8.5cm height £50-70
