On 26th August 1941, whilst on an air firing exercise SGT. 'Bill' James Eric William Ballard 745731 RAFVR failed to return in Spitfire Vb W3503 DQ-Q. He was 23 years old. Included with the logbook is a photograph album which shows SGT. Ballard in training and later photographs of him in flight gear and in his Spitfire. A very interesting and tragic collection showing the reality of life in Fighter Command during the early years of the Second World War.
